There is no interval.



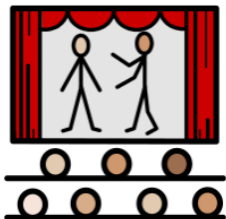

What is the performance?



The piece is a **mixture of theatre, dance and mime.**



It was created by **Open Theatre's ensemble company.**

It explores complex human emotions, and the story of a young woman who:

- wants a better life
- is navigating love, chaos and identity
- is searching for belonging and freedom



Open Theatre specialises in **non-verbal physical theatre** with young people with learning disabilities using **movement, music and visual storytelling** to connect audiences in ways that go beyond words.

The main entrance is located opposite the fountains on Centenary Square and has ramped access.

Level Access

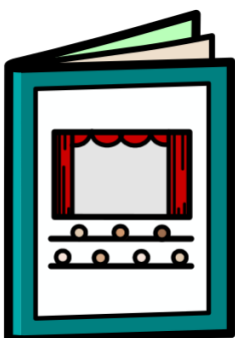


Level entry to the The Door auditorium with step-free seating access is available.

There will be **no strobe or flashing lights.**

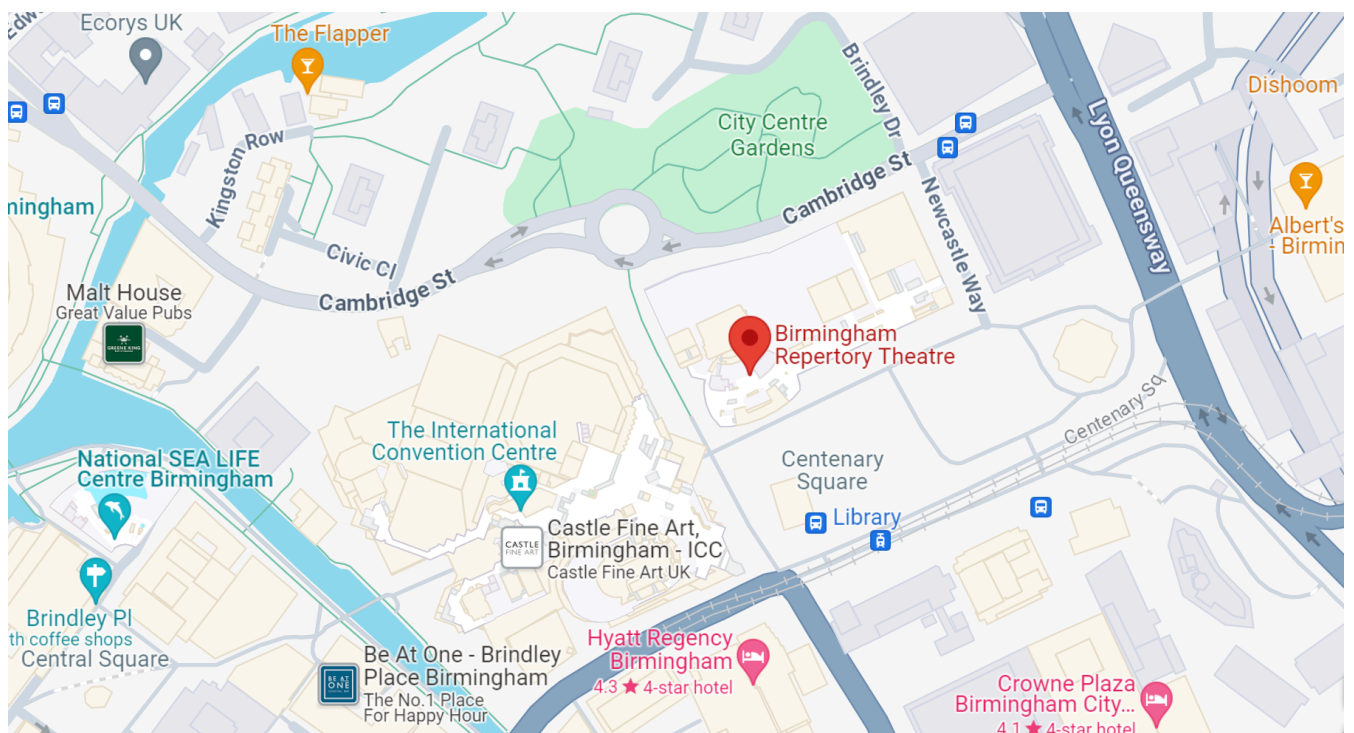
Venue Access Information

Travelling by Bus



There are bus stops **very close to the theatre**. They are about **2 minutes walk away**.

Many buses stop outside, including:

1, 9, 10, 10H, 22, 23, 24, 29, 29A, 29S, 120, 126, 127, 128, 129, 139, 140, 141, 821 and 829.

Travelling by Train



If you are traveling by train, here is the information needed for each station:



Birmingham New Street Station

- 15–20 minute walk
- Short taxi or tram ride



Birmingham Snow Hill Station

- 10–15 minute walk
- Short taxi or tram ride



Birmingham Moor Street Station

- 20 minute walk
- Short taxi ride



Five Ways Station

- 20 minute walk
- Short taxi ride

Travelling by Car



Follow the signs for City Centre and International Convention Centre (ICC) as well as Birmingham Rep (**use B1 2EP for Sat Nav**).

Birmingham REP **does not have its own car park.**

For **Blue Badge holders**, parking is available outside Brindley Drive car park and on Cambridge Street at the rear of the building, but spaces are extremely limited.

Recommended Parking:

- **Q-Park Brindley Place** - (Brunswick Street, Birmingham, B1 2JP) (what3words for entrance: ///than.beam.exist)
- **Mailbox Car Park** - (Royal Mail Street, Mailbox, B2 2RD) (what3words for entrance: ///clocks.cats.blast)

Please note that the Birmingham REP is within **Birmingham's Clean Air Zone** which may affect your journey if you are travelling by car. Please head to the [Brum Breathes website](#) for more information.

The **taxi drop-off** for the venue is on **Cambridge Street**, by the Rep Stage Door.

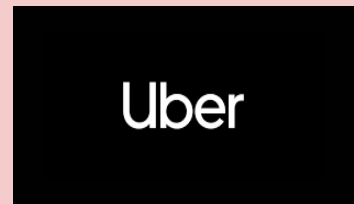
